This General Price List reflects Chapman Funeral Homes is committed to provide consumer information to each family we are privileged to serve.

We know it is important that you understand the alternatives available to you as well as the specific costs for each of those services. We are confident you will find the information you need within this price list. However, should you have any questions, we welcome your inquiry. Please allow us to give you full information to assist you in your family's decisions.

Our personal service to you also includes assistance with insurance claims, Veteran's benefits, insurance processing, social security assistance, letters of verifications to employers and airlines. We also arrange for appointments of cemetery property, procurement of certified death certificates, notification to newspapers, both local and out-of-area, and other special services to your family. Our family service staff and funeral directors provide personal services after the funeral, at no additional cost to the family.

We are honored by the confidence you have placed in us and are committed to your service and satisfaction.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any pre-need agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

Itemized Prices

The GOODS and SERVICES shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Professional Services

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF and OVERHEAD \$ 1,395

Availability of funeral director and staff to respond 24 hours a day; administrative services including preparation of death certificate, securing doctor's signature, and filing with proper authorities; securing burial or cremation authorization and/or transit permit locally; clerical administration and preparation of various forms of including Social Security and Veterans Administration; planning, supervision and follow-up on all details of arrangement conference with cemetery, crematory, clergy, or other third parties; and shelter of remains. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already in our charges for cremations, immediate burial, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING \$ 750

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary; however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it such as direct cremation or immediate burial. (California state law requires embalming or refrigeration of deceased if held for more than 24 hours after time of death.)

REFRIGERATION/SHELTER OF REMAINS \$ 490

This is for a 3-day period, 65.00 for each day thereafter.

PREPARATION OF EMBALMED BODY \$ 200

This fee includes, Cosmetology, Dressing and Casketing, Hairdressing.

SPECIAL CARE FOR AUTOPSIED REMAINS \$ 200

PREPARATION OF UNEMBALMED REMAINS..... \$ 250

Includes dressing, setting features, and placing deceased in casket or container.

TOPICAL DISINFECTION, NO EMBALMING \$ 150

REFILE DISPOSITION PERMIT..... \$ 50

INTERNATIONAL SHIPPING ADMINISTRATIVE FEE \$ 650

Includes charges levied by consulates and/or other government agencies required to ship remains internationally.

INFANT/CHILD PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Does not include charges for cost of merchandise and/or outside services needed. Our charges for children's services are based on a percentage of the standard professional fees for a Traditional Funeral Service:

Still Birth to 2 years of age..... 25% or \$998
3 years to 6 years of age..... 45% or \$1,798
7 years to 14 years of age..... 75% or \$2,996

This does not include the container (air tray) used for forwarding the remains, viewing or funeral ceremony, transportation to local funeral home or airport, or any other merchandise.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$ 1,495

Includes basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, temporary shelter of remains, preparation of remains, transportation of remains to local cemetery or crematory. This does not include viewing or funeral ceremony, or any other merchandise.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

Includes basic service of funeral director, staff and overhead, removal of remains, refrigeration, and local transportation to cemetery (drop off only, no service). This does not include cost of casket, embalming or other preparation of remains. YOU MAY CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:
