Professional Services

Availability of funeral director and staff to respond 24 hours a day; administrative services including preparation of death certificate, securing doctor's signature, and filing with proper authorities; securing burial or cremation authorization and/or transit permit locally; clerical administration and preparation of various forms of including Social Security and Veterans Administration; planning, supervision and follow-up on all details of arrangement conference with cemetery, crematory, clergy, or other third parties; and shelter of remains. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.
