3. Explore South Congress

South Congress, otherwise known as SoCo, is a one-of-a-kind district. This pedestrian mall offers an eclectic mix of restaurants, shops, and attractions all within walking distance, as well as a free trolley to take you from one end to the other. The Drag is also known by locals as Guadalupe Street and is well-respected for its vibrant nightlife. With its many bars, restaurants, and live music venues that line both sides of the street, this nightlife hot spot is certainly worth a visit.
