### Location

Deerfoot Inn & Casino - Conference Centre, 11500 - 35 Street SE Calgary, Alberta.

### Vendor & Display Tables

Tables are 30" X 6' or 30" X 8'. Table rent based on \$10.00 per foot.

Table Rent: Vendors 6' - \$60.00 and 8' - \$80.00 per table. Exhibitors 6' - \$30.00 and 8' - \$40.00 per table.

Tables are rented to the lessee to buy, sell, trade or display Militaria and related material only. All items must comply with current laws. Table coverings are not provided but as per venue rules, table covers are mandatory for all tables.

### Registrant & Helper Ribbons

Registrants will be issued a maximum of two (2) free event ribbons, one for the Registrant and one (1) for the First Helper. Additional helper ribbons must be purchased in advance with registration and will not be sold at the show. The registrant and all helpers must be identified on the registration form. This information determines the number of event ribbons and chairs for each registrant, helping us with event planning and venue setup.

### Table Reservation and Payment

Tables are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Tables will be reserved and assigned upon receipt of a properly completed and signed registration form submitted with full payment. A signature and full payment complete a contract between the CMS and the registrant. Payment may be made as follows:

### **Friday July 18, 2025 - Participant Set-Up**

Set up times - 7:00 am until 5:00 pm. There will be no entry into the Show Venue before 7:00 AM. Materials must be carted or carried by hand as **there is No Vehicle access into the building** for unloading and loading.

### **Saturday July 19, 2025 - Public Show**

Open to the public - 10:00 am until 3:00 pm

### **Participant Take Down**

Take down - 3:00 pm till 5:00 pm. Participants must vacate the venue by 5:00 pm.

### **Reporting In**

There will be signage on the door indicating access to the registration table. Enter and present yourself to the volunteer at the registration table. Give the name that the table has been registered under. You will receive an envelope with the table number(s) and your registrant and helper ribbons. All exhibitors and helpers must be wearing ribbons to enter the venue.

### **Parking**

Parking on site is free however the overall number of spaces may be limited. You are responsible for your vehicle and its contents at all times.

### **Security**

The Calgary Military Show provides volunteer security during show hours. Please be aware that you are responsible for the security of your tables before, during and after the show. **Participant Ribbons are for table renters and their helpers only and must be worn in the show area at all times**. There Are No Exceptions.

### **Contracts**

Each exhibitor shall have his or her own contract in his or her own name, not a company name. No group registrations under one name.

### **Exhibitor Conduct**

The Calgary Militaria Show's aim is to maintain tasteful, high-quality presentations. To achieve this, the show is looking for high quality displays and clean, organized tables.

Calgary Militaria Show events are nondenominational and nonpolitical. We ask registrants and their helpers to not wear T-Shirts or other garments with offensive or provocative wording or images.

Theme dress matching displays and military reenactor groups in period or historical uniforms, are most welcome.

Our compliance with all laws and regulations will be monitored and enforced.

## **Show Regulations**

1. **This is a militaria show.** Vendor, Collector/Trade or Exhibit Display tables must be 100% militaria or related items only including books or collectibles. Deviation from this regulation must be explained to Calgary Militaria Shows for prior approval. If this procedure is not followed, you may be asked to remove unacceptable articles. Non-compliance may ban you from future shows.
2. You must comply with all Calgary Militaria Show (CMS) and Deerfoot Inn & Casino Conference Centre (DICCC) regulations and Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws.
3. When, if and where applicable, you must comply with all Municipal, Provincial and Federal Health regulations and guidelines. While within the facilities the wearing of masks is optional, those choosing to wear a mask at this event are most welcome to do so.
4. All participants and attendees must register upon entering the facilities.
5. The Show Committee reserves the right to remove any exhibitor who is disrespectful in any way to anyone, or who sets up tables that are deemed unsuitable for this show, or who refuses to abide by any of these rules.
6. All show participants including collectors, exhibitors, vendors, helpers, and show volunteers must wear their Participant Ribbons within the venue at all times. Show Participant Ribbons are not transferable. Individuals found in the venue during set-up time not displaying ribbons will be escorted from the building, no exceptions.
7. The Show reserves the right to prohibit the sale or display of any items it deems inappropriate as per regulations #1 and #5.
8. Show participants are responsible for their table(s). Theft, misuse and damage can and do happen. Have your table staffed, monitored or under constant supervision at all times. CMS and DICCC accept no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged articles.
9. CMS and DICCC require that all tables have table covers.
10. All children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by parent/guardian as per CMC and DICCC regulations.

## **Firearms, Ammunition or their Components**

11. Only deactivated military firearms and military firearms that qualify for antique status under Canadian law may be sold.
12. The sale of any military firearm that requires a Possession and Acquisition License (PAL) is prohibited.

13. Live military firearms and ammunition may be displayed but not sold, provided that all Federal, Provincial and Municipal regulations are adhered to. For clarification, please contact the Show's Management or Alberta's Chief Firearms Office.
14. The sale of all non-military firearms (antique, de-activated, non-restricted, prohibited, restricted, replicas, airsoft, pellet, model or toy) is prohibited.
15. The sale of live ammunition or components (casings, primers, powder and projectiles) is prohibited due to Insurance Costs and City of Calgary Fire Regulations.

### **Table Rentals and Exhibit Area**

16. Tables are 30" X 6' or 30" X 8' and are rented and assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
17. Tables or space obtained under contract, as defined and agreed upon in the Registrant's Table Registration, are not transferable. Reassignment requires prior approval of the CMS.
18. Rental cancellations will be accepted up to **21 days** before the day of the show. After this, there will be no refund.
19. There will be a \$50.00 charge for any NSF cheque in addition to repaying your registration fee.
20. For special table requirements or needs such as tables on a wall; tables back-to-back in a row or near or next to someone, state these on your application form or in your email request including the name of your desired neighbour if you have one. CMS will endeavour to honour and comply with your request but please be aware that time and circumstance may make addressing your request impossible.
21. If you intend to put up flyers, decorations or advertising, we ask that you use free standing displays or painters tape/masking tape. No pins, scotch tape or duct tape allowed.
22. No display or table items may protrude into the aisles, in front of exit doors or emergency equipment such as fire hoses or alarms as per City of Calgary Fire Regulations.
23. Packing up or leaving early upsets and disrespects paid attendees, reflecting poorly on the Show.  
  
Vendors & Exhibitors must remain fully set up for the duration of the show (10:00am - 3:00pm) and are prohibited from packing up before 3:00pm without the consent of the CMS. Failure to comply will result in the registrant's removal from our mailing list and future events or in placement at the end of table registration waiting lists.
24. The Deerfoot Inn & Casino Conference Centre requires that Calgary Militaria Shows vacate the premises immediately following the closure of the show at 5:00 pm or an extra charge will apply.

## **Exhibitor Conduct**

25. No exhibitor or vendor shall pack up and leave the show before closing without permission from the Show Committee or Chairman. Violators will be banned from all future Calgary Militaria Shows sanctioned events.
26. Deliberate misrepresentation of items offered for sale, dishonest sales practices or non-compliance with laws and show regulations will automatically expel you from the show and ban you from all future CMS sponsored shows.
27. Vendors, Collectors/Traders shall not exhibit for sale any fake or fraudulent material. Reproductions, refurbished, restored and repaired items must be clearly identified as such. To keep it simple:

**If you have any doubt at all about an item's authenticity or its provenance, you have agreed not to sell it here.**

28. No alcohol or alcoholic beverages are allowed within the show premises before, during or after the show.
29. Smoking is absolutely prohibited as per City of Calgary Bylaws.
30. Verbal abuse is not acceptable and will not be tolerated. Submit complaints to the CMS and the HSCA in writing.
31. Please ensure there is no foul language either spoken or on items you are selling.
32. Calgary Military Show events are nondenominational and nonpolitical. We ask registrants and their helpers to not wear T-Shirts or other garments with offensive or provocative wording or images.
33. Please be aware that CMS takes event photos at random throughout the show. Unless you state otherwise, your photo may be taken at some point during the show by the CMS.
