Dear Client,

Welcome to the Long Valley Interfaith Food Pantry, a branch of the Long Valley Community Assistance Program (LVCAP). We are a community of local churches dedicated to providing a sustenance pantry stocked with items meant to help supplement your family's nutritional needs.

Our Interfaith Food Pantry follows the Washington Township school schedule. We are open most Monday mornings from 10am to noon, and most first and third Monday evenings from 6pm to 7:30pm. We have included a calendar listing of important dates for your reference throughout the year.

Each client is allowed a total of 6 bags of groceries per month, with a 3 bag limit per shopping trip.

In addition to your monthly food items we also offer additional Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter distributions. To celebrate the Christmas season we also provide Christmas gifts for your children ages newborn through grade 12. Each Easter the parishioners of St. Luke's Roman Catholic Church provide Easter baskets for participating children. Pre-registration is required to participate in either, or both of these programs.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION...

- We provide each client family with 3 re-usable shopping bags. You are required to bring these 3 bags with you when you shop at the Food Pantry. If you forget your bags then 3 brown paper/plastic bags will be provided for your use. In accordance with our guidelines the use of outside shopping bags will no longer be permitted.
- There are only 2 clients allowed in the pantry at one time. All clients are helped on a first come/first serve basis. All clients must sign in upon arriving to use the pantry and wait outside until their name is called. Please be considerate and wait your turn.

Thank you for your patience as we work to continue to provide assistance to the families of Washington Township.
