We are Carroll Materials and we have been using Texas Refinery products for over 10 years. Our business originally started in 1952 but we were recently bought out by Allstate Materials Group in 2019. We source and manufacture ready-mix concrete and asphalt for residential, commercial, and industrial applications. Our customer base is made up of both large and small customers, primarily in Maine and parts of New Hampshire. With such a large operation and area to serve, it is important that we can trust the products that go into our expensive machines, to ensure that they we are running smoothly every single day without any hiccups.

Our equipment consists of our Terex Concrete Trucks, Terex Front Discharge Loaders, Volvo & MACK concrete & dump trucks, and CAT 966M Front Loaders & CAT CB13 Rollers. For all our equipment, we use Texas Refinery Corp's Paragon 3000 Grease. We use the Paragon 3000 #2 year-round, except when we get into the winter months, we switch to Paragon 3000 #1. We trust this grease because of its ability to function at the highest level for long durations and in very harsh conditions. Our working environment is naturally filled with dirt & dust from the crushing we do to create our asphalt and concrete, plus our equipment is prone to produce a lot of heat during working hours. Paragon 3000 is applied to all our heavy-duty trucks through auto lubricators and equipment while it is also applied daily to our crushing machines. Because we mostly work 10-hour days throughout the year, our equipment is always operating and experiences a lot of wear and tear. Paragon 3000 helps us keep up our fast-paced operation while also protecting our equipment against the harsh working conditions and long working days.
