

Create a Pointillism Masterpiece

You will need:

White paper or canvas, a pencil, acrylic paint, a paint palette, and some Q-tips
(Separate ones for each color)

Directions

FLOWERS

1. Choose 2 colors of paint for each flower and squeeze them onto your palette. (Total 6)
2. Dip a Q-tip in your first color. Make dots inside the first flower. Leave space for color no. 2.
3. Dip a new Q-tip in your second color. Make dots in the empty spaces.
4. Repeat steps 3 and 4 for each flower.

STEMS

5. Choose 2 shades of green for your flowers' stems and squeeze them onto your palette.
6. Dip a Q-tip in your first green. Make dots along the stem. Leave space for color no. 2.
7. Dip a new Q-tip in your second color. Make dots in the empty spaces.

VASE

8. Choose 2 shades of brown (or any other color) for your vase. Squeeze onto your palette.
9. Dip a Q-tip in your first color. Make dots inside the vase. Leave space for color no. 2.
10. Dip a new Q-tip in your second color. Make dots in the empty spaces.
11. Hang your picture up to dry.
12. Now, take a big step back. What do you see? Do the colors blend together?
