Recaps must be filled out completely and correctly. If scores are not filled out and turned in then the youth will not earn their raffle tickets for prizes from the program, and they also could miss out on honor scores and scholarship money for the youth that have a sanction card.

At the end of league play the recap will appear on the screen for 5 minutes to then use to copy and confirm the scores.

For our Junior and All-Star divisions, it is the responsibility of each youth bowler to ensure that their score is written down, the sheet filled out completely, and that the scores are legible. The sheet must be checked by a coach before being turned into the desk.
