BASIC ETIQUETTE FOR BOWLERS

- 1. Be courteous to teammates, opponents, coaches, officials, parents, and center personnel
- 2. Show good sportsmanship
- 3. Bowling shoes must be worn at all times while actively bowling
- 4. Properly store personal bags and equipment when not in use
- 5. Stay behind the foul line at all times
- 6. Be ready to bowl when it is your turn
- 7. Wait to bowl until the pinsetter and sweeper have completely set the pins up on the lane
- 8. When multiple bowlers are ready to bowl at the same time, let the bowler on your right go first
- 9. Leave the approach after your ball hits the pins
- 10. Sit down when it is not your turn to bowl
- 11. Do not climb or sit on top of chairs or console
- 12. Do not bother other bowlers as they prepare to bowl
- 13. Let the coaches know of any balls or pins that are stuck
- 14. Keep all food and drinks in the settee area behind the lanes
- 15. Do not run around or horseplay in the bowler area
- 16. Return rental shoes and bowling balls to their correct storage places
- 17. Use appropriate language at all times
