# Operation School Bell Spring Affaire

Assistance League of Los Angeles/Operation School Bell is one of the seven charities to which NGA donates and one to which 12 NGA members (and most NGA Board Members) are members of both organizations. We have donated over \$85,000 of shoes, uniforms and boxers to OSB in the past several years for LAUSD school children from kindergarten thru fifth grade living beneath the poverty line and often times homeless. OSB provides over 6,000 LAUSD children with white polo shirts and navy uniform bottoms, shoes, backpacks, jackets, socks, underwear, jeans and tops, as well as a book, toy, and grooming kit with soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, and hairbrush. These are all luxuries to these children.



This year OSB was able to purchase a new trailer which provides services to 250 or more children in one day by going out to the eight LAUSD school districts and having several local schools bring children in need to the host school. The current trailer which was donated by Mervyn's 15 years ago was on its last legs and a critical service was in jeopardy. OSB raised \$250,000 for the trailer at their 2016 May fundraiser "A Spring Affaire" at the Four Seasons in Beverly Hills. NGA is a past Spring Affaire honoree for our participation as a donor/partner with OSB. This year's 2017 event on May 14 at the same venue had the theme "Let's Fill the Truck" referring to the new trailer that was being delivered in May that required new inventory. Given our mission to provide clothing to agencies in need, NGA was asked to participate in a challenge match at the event. For every dollar that was raised in the "Dress a Child" campaign during the luncheon portion of the event, NGA would match up to \$20,000 with gifts of uniforms and shoes. The crowd enthusiastically responded with envelope gifts totalling over \$30,000 so with NGA's match, the room raised over \$50,000. Accepting this challenge helped NGA double the amount were able to give to OSB. Our portion purchased 5,080 white polos for OSB.

Thank you to all the NGA members who attended the 2017 "A Spring Affaire", as well as those who participated in the OSB Prom Days in May and our November 2016 meeting where we helped dress OSB students, made grooming kits and prepped shoes for the shelves.



NGA was recognized at the May 25, 2017 OSB end-of-year meeting as a wonderful partner to their organization. The chairmanship of the organization transitioned from NGA member Flo Fowkes to NGA members as Co-Chairs Kiel Fitzgerald and Shelagh Callahan who were sworn in that night.
