Consultation in relation to "Extending the Bench"

15 responses were received by the Seneschal and Policy and Finance Committee Some casual comments were also given by members of the public.

- Of the written submissions:-
- 6 of those were generally in favour of the proposal to extend the bench with the addition of a pool of persons to sit with the Seneschal to form a bench of three.
- 5 guardedly in favour, but considered that there should be more extensive reform of the Court, particularly in respect of legally trained assistance to the Court.
 - 2 were against any change.
 - 2 considered the present court not fit for purpose.
 - Most considered that remuneration should be in the form of expenses only.
 - No clear indication as to title. "Jure" favoured by some, including the present Seneschal, to avoid confusion with "Jurats" in Guernsey and Jersey.
 - Most settled for appointment for 3 year terms.
