There is still time to pay your dues for the 2025-2026 season. Please pay them by December 31.

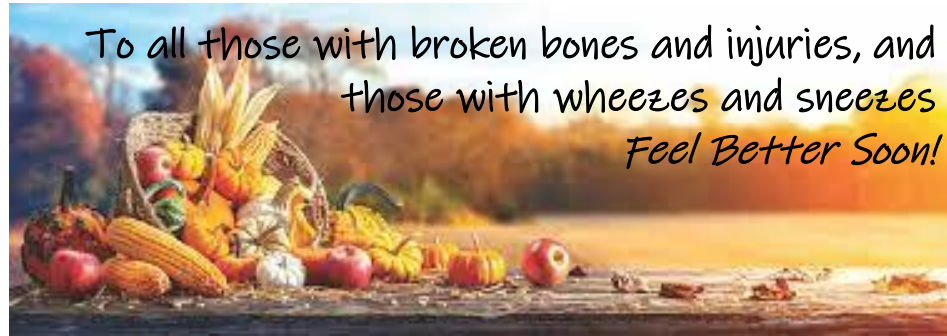
Corresponding Secretary / Webmaster's Report
