December 21, 2024 marks the first day of winter.

The winter solstice, also called the hibernal solstice, occurs when either of Earth's poles reaches its maximum tilt away from the Sun. This happens twice yearly, once in each hemisphere (Northern and Southern). For that hemisphere, the winter solstice is the day with the shortest period of daylight and longest night of the year,

and when the Sun is at its lowest daily maximum elevation in the sky. Each polar region experiences continuous darkness or twilight around its winter solstice. The opposite event is the summer solstice. *Source: Wikipedia.com*



This year, December 25 marks the merging of the Christian and Jewish calendars. It is Christmas Day and the first day of Hanukkah, which begins at sunset. It falls on a Wednesday and is the 360th day of the year, with only 9 more days remaining in the year of 2024. It is followed by the first day of Kwanza on December 26, an annual African-American celebration that was first celebrated in 1966.
