Trips

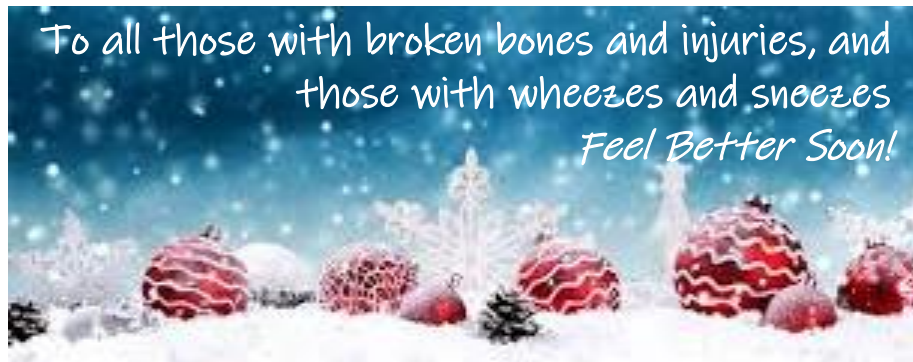
A few members will be skiing in Keystone from March 7 – 14, 2026. If you would like to join them, please contact Mark Sternefeld at 917-559-5002.

Each year on December 7, Pearl Harbor Survivors, veterans, and visitors from all over the world come together to honor and remember the 2,403 service members and civilians who were killed during the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941. A further 1,178 people were injured in the attack, which permanently sank two U.S. Navy battleships (the USS Arizona and the USS Utah) and destroyed 188 aircraft.

On August 23, 1994, the United States Congress designated December 7 as National Pearl Harbor

Remembrance Day. Every year, remembrance events are held at the Pearl Harbor National Memorial, culminating in a commemoration ceremony on December 7. Source: www.nps.gov

For the Northern Hemisphere, the winter solstice occurs every year on December 21 or 22 (The Southern Hemisphere's winter solstice occurs in June).
