

Enzian Ski Club Meeting Minutes
Thursday, April 9, 2026

After enjoying sandwiches, beer and wine, the meeting was called to order at 1:05 p.m. President Klaus Reh welcomed the 13 members in attendance. A moment of silence was observed for members who have passed away and for those currently recovering from illness or surgery.

President Klaus Reh moved to open the meeting.

Stacey Zegla read the minutes from the March 12th meeting. The minutes were accepted as read by all.

Financial Secretary Karlheinz Wagner reported that nine members have not yet paid their dues; however, one payment was received last week. Members are respectfully reminded to remit payment at their earliest convenience.

Treasurer Inge Biehl gave the financial report which was accepted as read.

It was noted that the Deutscher Club will host a Spring Craft Fair on the same date as the Dinner Dance, raising concerns regarding parking availability. The Craft Fair will begin at 11:00 am, and the Dinner Dance at 12:00 pm. Where would the 31 members expected to attend the Dinner Dance park? Klaus spoke with Ewald, who was present at the building today, to request that 20 parking spaces be reserved for Ski Club members attending the Dinner Dance.

The trail to the lift proved somewhat challenging due to an uphill section; however, assistance from younger participants was appreciated. The huts offered excellent food, and members had the opportunity to attend an excursion to watch Mikaela Shiffrin win a gold medal. Cortina was notably crowded due to the Olympics, though spirits remained high. The Boston Ski Club provided excellent support throughout the trip.

Klaus will attempt to contact Walter Fink regarding the establishment of a distinguished service award for the club's longest-tenured member (since 1964), potentially including a waiver of dues. Correspondence will be sent to the address on file.

A destination for next year's ski trip was discussed, and different ski resorts were mentioned for the Western part of the United States. A destination will be selected at an upcoming meeting.
