Dancing Out of Sets Strictly and Positively Forbidden

REGULATIONS

"No Member whose dues are in arrears over six months will be allowed to compete, etc."
See Article XIV, Sec. 2, of Constitution.

Competitors will be governed by the Rules adopted by the Club.

Each Game will be announced by the bugle call, and competitors must enter their name with the Secretary without delay. The last name entered will open the competition.

No entries will be received after the Game has commenced.

Only two prizes awarded if no more than three competitors enter in any event. None but members of Sister Societies, in good standing, allowed to compete in Closed Events.

Competitors in the Handicap Races will be allowed one yard for each year under or over the standard.

Handicap, 10 feet for each year for boys between the ages of 12 and 18 years.

Members of Sister Societies not Required to Pay Entrance Fees, at Games, upon Producing Receipt of Good Standing
