WHEREAS, Tartan Day, federally and state-recognized, honors Scottish Americans' contributions to the United States. Scottish engineer Andrew Smith Hallidie revolutionized urban transportation by inventing the world's first cable car system in San Francisco in 1873; and

WHEREAS, John McLaren, a Scottish horticulturist and past president of the San Andrew's society of San Francisco, dedicated 53 years to shaping Golden Gate Park as its Superintendent. His vision and leadership transformed the park into one of the world's greatest green spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Saint Andrew's Society of San Francisco, Caledonian Club of San Francisco, and Saint Andrews's Society Foundation have collectively preserved Scottish heritage and offered initiatives that further strengthen San Francisco's social fabric; and

WHEREAS, these organizations enrich the city's cultural landscape and support various charitable initiatives including educational and community outreach programs.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco recognizes and honors Scottish Americans for their extraordinary contributions to San Francisco; and
