Action Discussion

a) Presentation of the Draft Water Year 2024 Annual Report.

Lauren Wicks from Geoscience Support Services presented the draft Annual Water Report. Some highlights from the 2024 Annual Report include but is not limited to the following:

- Groundwater Storage was estimated to increase approximately 11,400 acre-feet during Water Year 2024.
- Precipitation during the water year is classified as above normal with 25.79 inches of rainfall at Henshaw Dam.
- Groundwater elevations in the fall of 2024 were higher in almost every monitored well.
- Both the Groundwater levels and storage in all representative monitoring sites are all above the minimum thresholds indicated in the Groundwater Sustainability Plan.
- While there appears to be a small uptick in the TDS and Nitrate as NO₃ levels in the basin, the changes in calculated ambient water quality could be a product of uncertainty with the current methodology and may no be reflective of actual changing conditions.
- Groundwater pumping is below the estimated safe yield for the subbasin.
