Petition filed under sec 63 (B) of the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Act of 1959.

1. Arumignu Subramaniaswami Kollu herein after called (Temple) situated in Vendakottai Village in Pattukkottai Taluk was founded by the four Karadhars of the Village and was in their management and administration from time immemorial.

2. In the year 1911 the members belonging to four Karats numbering 23 entered into an arrangement regarding the management and administration of the Temple, reduced it in writing in the form of a deed of settlement dated 19-8-1911, and registered as document No. 5208/1911. The settlement deed dated 19.08.1911, a copy of which is filed here with as document No. 1 provides as follows.

(1). That the Temple and its properties shall be administered and protected by five Dharmakarthas from among the 23 Karadhars namely :-

1. Govindasamy Vellalar S/o. Dharmaraja Vellalar
2. Rasappa Vellalar S/o. Thambi Raya Vellalar
3. Chokkalinga Chettiar S/o. Sami Chettiar
4. Govindasamy Nayakar S/o. Vadamalai Nayakar and
5. Rengasamy Mudhaliar S/o. Ramasamy Mudhaliar.

(11). That the persons named above to officiate as Thalaimadhars - Dharmakarthas (Trustees), maintain proper accounts and make proper arrangements for the performance of the festivals and daily poojas.

(111). The Karadhars of the village who were the parties to the settlement dated 19.08.1911, gave up their right in the management of the Temple and nominated the five persons named above as the Dharmakarthas to be in the management for a period of 10 years. Thereafter the Dharmakarthas were to continue in the management, and in case of their death their legal heirs to continue in the management and administration of the Temple as the Dharmakarthas.

Since the date of the above settlement the Temple was under the administration and the management of the five Dharmakarthas named above. They have made improvements in the Temple and they have been arranging for the performance of festivals and Pujas regularly.

4. During the settlement survey in the year 1958, the Temple, its tank and the area Appurtenant to the Temple was resurveyed as S.No.8 measuring 2.13 acres Besides the Temple own 8.31 acres included in S.No.111 which is entered in the name of the Temple represented by the Trustees Dharmaraja Vellar, Rasappan, Rengasamy Chettir, Chidambaram Mudhaliar and Arunachala Thondamar who were the legal heirs five Dharmakarthas nominated under the settlement deed. Even today the properties owned by the Temple is entered in the name Sri. Subramania swamy Temple represented by the Trustees, in the Village Revenue records (A copy of the Chitta is filed herewith

5. Since the resurvey and settlement in the year 1958, the five Trustees named in the settlement register carried on the management and administration of the Temple. The persons named as Trustees in the settlement register of the year 1958 died leaving behind petitioners as their legal representatives who continue in the management of the Temple as Trustees.

7. The petitioners are the descendants of the five Dharmakarthas nominated under the settlement deed dated 19.08.1911. A Genealogy showing the succession of the present Trustees from the original five Dharmakarthas are enclosed herewith.

8. The petitioners 1 to 5 are the descendants/ legal heirs of Govindasamy Vellar, Dharmaraja Vellar, Chokkalingam Chettir, Govinda Nayakar and Rengasamy Mudhaliar respectively.

9. The Temple was being administered, festivals are being conducted and the Pujas were being performed in the Temple by the petitioners and their predecessors in interest.

5. The petitioners, as hereditary Trustees are prepared to function within the provisions of the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Act and rules framed there under.

16. A Court Fee of Rs.15/- affixed as per the rules framed under the H.R. & C.E. Act.

17. The petitioners therefore pray that this Court may be pleased to grant a declaration that they are the Hereditary Trustees of Sri. Subramaniaswamy Temple, Vendakottai in Pattukkottai Taluk of Thanjavur District, and their successors are entitled to continue the management and administration of the Temple as hereditary Trustees.
