

June Fun League West Hills Trap Range June 3 - 25, 2025

FEES Teams will consist of a maximum of 5 shooters.. Spring League runs 4 weeks in June. Member fees are \$80 or \$20 per week. Non-members participating in the Spring League are required to participate in a safety briefing and review and sign the Hold Harmless Agreement prior to shooting their first league-night score. Non-member fees are \$80 or \$20 per week. All participants will pay a \$3 one-time fee for lead mitigation. FEES MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO SHOOTING FOR SCORE.

SCORING & TRAPPING Team score sheets will be at the range prior to shooting. Each team must provide their own scorekeeper and trapper. This may be the same person.

SCHEDULE The June Fun League will be held on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, beginning at 5pm. Saturdays from 10 to 1 will also be open as a designated shoot day, for make ups or shooting ahead if WHSTF is open. The squad leader or designee, in the presence of the scorer, is to initial acceptance of the scores immediately following the completion of the round.

SHOOT ORDER- Shooting will occur one night, Tuesday or Wednesday, in June. If the League night is missed, the participant may shoot on Saturday at WHSTF if the range is open. This make-up day may not exist. Shooters may shoot ahead of any league night. Make-up is allowed for team score only if shot during the current shoot week (Tuesday-Wednesday-Saturday). Makeups shot after that week will only count for individual scores.

<u>CLASSIFICATIONS</u> All teams will shoot from the 16-yard line. No handicaps will be enforced. Adjustments to awards may occur if a super-duper exceptional team participates. If classifications become a valid point, those who recognize them may take on the League for the next round.

NO STEEL SHOT! Shotgun shells must be provided by participants. There will be 50 rounds each week per shooter.

NO ALCOHOL Shooters may not consume alcohol before or during league shoots. No alcohol is permitted at West Hills Shooting & Training Facility.

<u>LINE-UP PROCEDURE</u> As West Hills only has one range, shooting times will be preassigned prior to the start of the League. If the scheduled team is not ready to shoot or does not show up on time, the next team present that is ready to shoot can move ahead and shoot. Questions? Ask trap help **before** you go to the line.

AWARDS Awards will be given to High Overall, High Female, High Male and 1st High Overall Team.

SPEEDING Shooters will adhere to 15 MPH while traveling on the paved road.

REMOVAL OF SPENT SHELLS All expended shells must be removed off the range by the shooter. Each squad leader will ensure that his/her team members are in compliance with aforementioned Trap League Rules.
