I am writing this letter in support of Mr. Carl Cole, and his Young Eagle Success (YES) program that we had participated in at Harlem Middle School. I have had the pleasure to work with Mr. Cole during two separate school years where I was able to observe and co-lead under his direction. This program was an opportunity for our students to reflect on their choices inside and outside of school and challenged our students to understand and accept responsibility for their own choices and actions.

Mr. Cole's approach to working with students is different from other interventions provided with his natural ability to connect with students. He allowed students to be themselves, which many times included behaviors not acceptable in classroom settings, while holding the students accountable without creating power struggles. Many of the students who participated in the groups found themselves regularly making poor choices that lead to missing school due to suspensions, detentions, or truancy, yet these students looked forward to coming to group meetings with more humility than in other school settings. Mr. Cole created an environment of support and accountability leading to a rapport many of the students struggled to find with other teachers or mentors in the school and was able to "chip away" at the walls these students formed due to trauma they experienced in their lives. Mr. Cole's experiences with at-risk youth in the community and direct understanding of many of the challenging situations that many students face outside of school helped students feel heard and seen in a way they may not have had in the past.

Mr. Cole worked with a total of four groups of students over the course of the 2021-22 and 2022-23 school years. This group may not be the best intervention for all students, but is a quality option for students who have struggled to connect with any mentor through other interventions. With this said, I recommend Mr. Carl Cole and the Young Eagle Success group to be an additional resource in your school. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.
