NOTES:

- ***T-SHIRTS** can be tank tops as long as the straps are wide and completely cover your bra.
- ****LEGGINGS** are good for under skirts & as PJs. They cannot be worn alone outside your hotel room unless covered with a skirt or long tunic.
- **PACK LIGHT!** We can do laundry in our rooms, or have it done as we go. QUICK-DRY materials are best to be sure clothes dry in time. DO NOT pack jeans and heavy clothing, your items should fit into your carry-on suitcase.
- **THEFT** is always possible when you travel abroad, DO NOT bring anything you can't afford to lose! Jewelry can make you a target, DO NOT bring large gem stones or flashy items.
- **THE WEATHER** in Kenya can be much cooler than you expect, but it can also be very warm. It is best to bring layers and be prepared. We will check weather the week before we leave.
- **ADAPTERS** - You will need an electric adapter to use the outlets, the UK adapter works in Kenya. (3 Prongs) Sam has a couple of power strips that travel with us, these are available for team use, depending on how many rooms we have.
