#00 Will Jeffress

6-7 Jr. Forward Pittsburgh 2022—Brings a wealth of international experience with him. Played in 31 of the Panthers' 32 contests, starting in 16 of those games. Helped Team USA to a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA U16 Americas Championship. Prepped at McDowell High where he was a three-time all-state selection and Finalist for Mr. Basketball in Pennsylvania.





#01 Matthew Kelly

5-10 Gr. Guard Assumption 2022— An NE-10 All-Conference selection, Kelly was one of two Greyhounds to start all 25 games this season. Led his team in points and minutes played. Scored in double figures 21 of his 25 starts, shooting 44% from the field and 39% from three. Named the WACBA Rookie of the Year, Kelly also led Quince Orchard High to the Regional Championship.





#02 Nate Santos

6-7 So. Forward Pittsburgh 2022—Prepped at Loomis Chaffe Academy averaging 17.1pts and 6rbs per game. Ranked the #2 prospect in Connecticut and #5 overall in New England. Established himself as the Panther's defensive presence in 2021-2022. Grabbed a season high 6 rebounds and put up a season high 14 points in a victory against Townson.





#03 Ethan McEachern

6-0 So. Guard Rochester

2022 — Played his freshman season at Trinity before transferring to Rochester for the 2022-23 season. Played in 24 of the team's 25 games. Dynamic guard posted 88 assists to just 33 turnovers in his freshman campaign, including a season high 12 assists against Elms. Prepped at national powerhouse Blair Academy where he was team captain and led his team to a state title.





#04 James Taylor Jr.

5-9 Sr. Guard Mercy

2022—Played his freshman season at Neosho Community College before transferring ahead of the 2020-21 season. The Thomas Dale High School star led Mercy in scoring in his initial season. Also led the team in minutes played while playing in 20 of the Mavericks' games and starting in 19 of those outings. Ended 14 games with double digit point totals this season.





#05 Jordan Jefferson

6-2 So. Guard Arkansas Little Rock 2022—Jefferson, as a true freshman, was a standout for the Trojans in 2021-2022, leading the team in scoring three times with a season-high of 24 points in the first round of the Sun Belt Conference. A standout player at Osborne High School earning all-county honors and a spot with Train Like A Pro Sports Academy.





#07 Aundre Hyatt

6-6 Sr. Forward Rutgers
2022—Played in 32 games averaging 12.8 minutes with a season high 13
points in a win over Clemson. Prior to Rutger, Hyatt played at LSU for 3 years.
He played in 53 games making 17 starts in his last 2 seasons. Recorded a 13
point, 10 rebound double-double leading his team to a win in the 1st round
NCAA Tournament.





#11 Mo Terry

6-4 Sr. Forward Lycoming 2022—Terry, along with teammate Dyson Harward, helped lead the Warriors to three consecutive Championship games. Averaging 11.3 points, 5.4 rebounds and 2 assists, Mo played in 25 games starting in 24. Averaged 1.2 steals per contest and led the Warriors in steals with 30. Prepped at Severn School where he was an al-conference selection.





#12 Noah McDavid

6-5 So. Guard Tarleton State 2022—Played in 31 games and started in the last 18 of the season. Scored 193 points on the season, averaging 6.2 points per game and had a season high 25 points against Dallas Christian. Prepped at Lake Highlands High where McDavid averaged 23.7 points, 5.6 rebounds, 2.7 assists, and 1.7 steals his senior season.





#14 Ebby Asamoah

6-4 Sr. Guard Delaware 2022—Playing in 33 of Delaware's 35 games this season, and receiving 20 starts, was efficient on the floor shooting 40.5% on the season and 39.1% from behind the arc. Scored 7 points per outing while grabbing 3.5 rebounds as well. Prepped at Magruder High School where he averaged 18 points and 9.9 rebounds per game.





#15 Dyson Harward

6-7 Sr. Forward Lycoming 2022— Harward, along with teammate Mo Terry, helped lead the Warriors to three consecutive Championship games, starting in all 27. Averaged a double-double with 13.1 points and 11.6 rebounds per game shooting 46% from the field. Had a season high 27 points in a win over FDU-Florham. Prepped at Danville Area High leading the team to 2 district championships.





#22 Panayiotis Pavlidis

6-8 Sr. Forward Molloy 2022— Medical red shirt this past season, Pavlidis shot 54% from the floor for Molloy in 2020-2021 and protected the rim with 1.2 blocks per game. Played 27 games, starting 17, in 2019-20. Ranked nationally in DII for total blocks and blocks per game while grabbing 6.8 rebounds per contest. Prepped at powerhouse Cardozo High where he led his team to the Borough Championship.



#42 Nigel John

6-9 So. Forward Arkansas Little Rock 2022—Played last season at Eastern Oklahoma State College. Appeared in 21 games making 14 starts. Averaged 9.5 points and 8.1 rebounds per game, efficiently shooting 53% from the floor. Recorded 39 blocks and 9 steals on the season. Was a 3 star recruit from the state of Texas where he was ranked #22 in the state for his class.
