Dear Scholarship Applicant,

This scholarship was created in loving memory of our brother, Angelo, who passed away suddenly at the age of 49 due to an aortic dissection caused by vascular Ehlers-Danlos syndrome (vEDS), and our father, also named Angelo, who died at age 51 from complications likely related to vEDS. Both left behind college-aged children who could have greatly benefited from the kind of support this scholarship offers.

We are honored to provide a **\$1,000 scholarship** to a few students who meets the following criteria:

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Submit **one** of the following in your preferred format: either a 750-word essay *or* a social media reel (no longer than 3 minutes):
 - **Option A:** Share how vEDS has impacted you and your family and explain why you have chosen your current academic or training path.
 - **Option B:** Describe what you envision your future to look like.
 - **Option C:** Illustrate a “day in the life” of a college student*. (**social media reel submission only*)
2. Include your current or upcoming semester **class schedule** from a college, trade school, or technical program.
3. Provide **proof of diagnosis** for your parent/legal guardian or for yourself if you are the de novo case (a doctor’s note is acceptable).
4. Submit **proof of a U.S. address**.
