Dear Scholarship Applicant,

This scholarship is in memory of our brother Angelo, who passed away unexpectedly at the age of 49, due to an aortic dissection directly related to vEDS, as well as our father, Angelo, who passed away at the age of 51 from complications suspected to be related to vEDS. Both left behind college-aged children who may have benefited from this type of scholarship.

To be eligible for this \$1,000 scholarship, you must satisfy <u>all</u> four (4) of the criteria listed below and complete the essay section of the application:

- 1) Any ONE (1) of the following:
 - a. A 1,500-word essay or a social media reel* (up to 5-minute max) on how vEDS has affected you and your family; as well as why you have chosen and are pursuing the program that you're in; or
 - b. A 1,500-word essay or a social media reel* (up to 5-minute max) on what do you envision your future to look like; or
 - c. A 1,500-word essay or a social media reel* (up to 5-minute max) on a day in the life of a college student
- 2) Provide your college/trade/technical school schedule for the current/or upcoming semester.
- 3) Proof of your parent's (or legal guardian's) diagnosis or your own diagnosis (doctor's note is fine).
- 4) Proof of address in the United States.
