

Title. VOTERS WITHOUT BORDERS - Full Political Rights for EU Citizens on the Move.

Subject-matter. We demand reforms to strengthen the existing rights of EU citizens to vote and stand in European and municipal elections in their country of residence and new legislation to extend them to regional, national elections and referenda.

Main objectives.

- Recognize EU citizens automatically as voters where they reside and remove obstacles to voting and standing in elections across borders.
- Renovate Universal Suffrage as a fundamental right and European value. EU-citizens should choose whether to vote in their country of residence or in the country of origins for all elections and referenda.
- Research the impact of such steps towards Universal Suffrage for EU citizens and how they could include third-country nationals.

These reforms will remove a stain in European democracy and create a space for transnational politics in line with Article 10(4) of the Treaty on European Union and

Article 12(2) of the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union.

Provisions of the Treaties considered relevant:

Articles 20, 22 and 25 (TFEU) and Articles 39 - 40 of the Charter of Fundamental Rights.
