Forget APEC and join us for a very special network breakfast event with guest speaker Dr Henry Welch Wednesday October 31, RPYC, K50

Dr Welch came to PNG with the Baylor College of Medicine-Texas Children's Hospital. Together, with The National Department of Health, and UPNG School of Medicine and Health Sciences they have made progress in the treatment of children with TB.

Many programs actively concentrate on adults with TB as they are the group that primarily transmits TB. Unfortunately, this means children often get left behind. Children are more susceptible to TB and more likely to die.

In the face of an increasing number of children presenting with multi drug-resistant TB (MDR-TB) the team have created new national paediatric TB guidelines. They have started TB prophylaxis to eligible children under 5 years of age, and have helped PNG implement a new child-friendly TB medication into the country, making it the 1st high-burden TB country to do so and the 4th country world-wide.
