HIV Facts

You cannot access treatment for HIV infection if you do not know your status.

The only way to know your HIV status is to get an HIV test.

In recent years one million people have died each year from HIV because they didn't know they were HIV positive and were NOT on treatment.

Ensure everyone in your workplace knows and understands their rights to live, travel, study or work irrespective of HIV status. People living with HIV have the same benefit as a normal person including fair treatment at work and they are covered by the HAMP Act. Key words to discuss from the song.

- Preventing TB/ HIV co-infection.
- The work and human rights of people living and working with HIV.
- Your HIV and TB workplace policy and supporting people to get tested and remain on treatment for either HIV or until cured of TB.
- Update your HIV workplace policy to address TB and other risk factors associated with the transmission of TB or HIV infection.
