- 1) The conditions set forth herein constitute the entire agreement between the parties. There are no representations or warranties expressed or implied. Any changes in the agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties. Show management has the right to render all interpretations and to establish further conditions as deemed necessary for the general success of the event.
- 2) Distribution of advertising material and exhibitor solicitation of any kind shall be restricted to the exhibitor's booth. Exhibitor display may not extend beyond the exhibitor's booth space, and no display or product may extend into the aisle. No exhibitor shall arrange their space as to obscure any adjacent exhibitor.
- 3) With the exception of not-for-profit organizations, by paying or nonpaying exhibitors, the selling of chances is strictly prohibited. Not for profit organizations must abide by all laws set forth by the State of Pennsylvania. Exhibitors may offer free door prizes or samples of their product or services to patrons.
- 4) Exhibitors shall be bound by all pertinent laws, codes and regulations of municipal or other authorities having jurisdiction over the facilities and grounds as well as any and all pertinent rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania DCNR & Bureau of Parks. .
- 5) Exhibitors must carry their own insurance. Show management, the State of Pennsylvania and the Department of Natural Resources is not responsible for the safety of the properties of the exhibitor, its officers, agents or employees from theft, damage by fire, accident or any other cause whatsoever, and the exhibitor expressly agrees to save and hold harmless the sponsors, hosts, show management, their employees, the State of Pennsylvania, the Department of Natural Resources from any and all liability resulting from injuries or damage to the exhibitors, their agents, employees, attendees, persons and/or properties in connection with the exhibitor use of the exhibit space.
- 6) It is agreed that if the vendor fails to comply in any respect with the terms of this agreement, the show management will have the right, without notice, to sell or offer for sale the space covered by this contract.

- 7) Exhibitor agrees that whenever an attorney is retained by show management and/or the promoter to represent the interest of show management and/or promoter in any civil or criminal proceeding, arbitration or mediation hearing arising out of the terms of this agreement or any disputes regarding payment due, contract view differences, participation difficulties, suits arising from exhibitor display from neglect or intentional act of the exhibitor or any other legal action including arbitration and mediator hearings hereunder, all attorney and court fees (both management, promoter and exhibitors) shall be paid by the exhibitor.
- 8) Sponsor or show management will not be liable for the fulfillment of this contract as to the delivery of the exhibit space if non delivery is due to any of the following causes: the facility being damaged or destroyed by fire, act of God, public enemy, war or resurrections, strike, the authority of law, or any other cause beyond their control. It will, however, in the event of not being able to hold the event for any of the above reasons, reimburse exhibitors any monies paid for vendor space.
- 9) No unpackaged food or food demonstrations are allowed without proper clearance from show management. Exhibitors must have all proper permits from all necessary state and local government agencies.
- 10) All food truck vendors must be up to date with all necessary state and local government agencies.
- 11) No vendor shall serve and or give away alcohol of any kind.
- 12) No Styrofoam coolers, containers or cups will be allowed on the grounds.
- 13) No glass containers will be allowed on the grounds.
- 14) This show will take place rain or shine.
- 15) All exhibitor booths must remain open all four days of the event right through closing on the final day.
- 16) Show management will have full power in the interpretation and enforcement of all rules and regulations contained herein and the power to make amendments thereto, and such further rules and regulations it shall deem necessary for the proper conduct and success of the event.
- 17) This agreement shall be governed by the applicable laws of the State of Pennsylvania.
