We are grateful for the efforts of our esteemed Race Director Kelsey Smithendorf, who championed the 2024 event.



FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Club financial support was received in 2024 from all sources, including membership dues and donations, totaling \$18,242 which was used to support club programs and expenses. Expenses of \$13,683 were incurred in the same period which primarily consisted of our 5K road race, donations to other charities, membership fees in the Road Runners Club of America, RCMalden branded tent for club events, general liability insurance, and D&O insurance. The club ended the period with savings of \$14,566.
