Through the firsthand experience as parents Shaun and Melanie have faced adversity and discrimination with their son Logan who was born with a rare genetic condition called Bpes.

Blepharophimosis, ptosis, and epicanthus inversus syndrome (BPES) is a rare developmental condition affecting the eyelids and ovary. Typically, four major facial features are present at birth: narrow eyes, droopy eyelids, an upward fold of skin of the inner lower eyelids and widely set eyes. These features cause difficulty in opening the eyes fully and may affect an affected individual's quality of vision.

Through this experience of supporting Logan. My support link was formed, Melanie had been working as an early childhood educator for the last 20 years and Shaun as HR Operations for Notfor-Profit Disability organisation.

Shaun and Melanie have both been working as Support Workers with Multiple reputable organisation's and with these experiences felt the need for a service that cares.



My support Link was launched in March 2022 and has now grown to employee ten staff and provide support across Tasmania and Victoria, providing support that provides an inclusive environment such as "A seat at my Kitchen Table" cooking program that caters for all skills and abilities.


