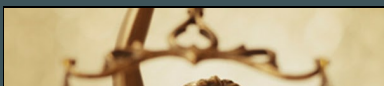
Easter Lily Dedication

We also elected two new board members: Deb Blossom and Diane Nickman. Welcome!

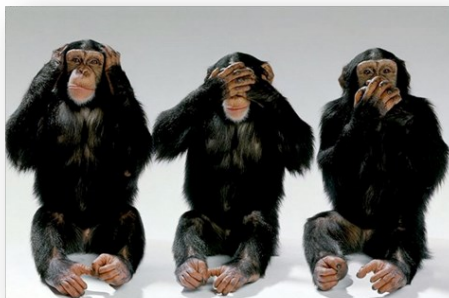
The Board presented the 2018 budget to clamorous approval.
