The Sufis represent the mystical side of Islam. They claim Mohammad as the first Sufi; he was their teacher and a representation of the Universal Man. Sufi tradition contains a vast metaphysical and cosmological set of doctrines that have been elaborated upon and taught by Sufi masters for centuries.

Mohammad founded Islam in the 7th century, and it has spread around the world. It is currently ranked second to Christianity. All Sufis are Muslim, with the exception of a few orders in the Western world.

Sufism has produced some of the greatest mystical poetry ever written, and given us some of the most vibrant and haunting music.

Sufism appeals those who zealously yearn for connection with Source. It provides a path back to the One through spiritual effort combined with joy and devotion.

The One is, of course, referred to as "Allah," and is known as the Supreme Source and End of All Things.

As we become intoxicated with the joy and truth of the mystical roots of Islam, we will enter through the Gates of Paradise. The first experience of this Paradise is at Tizer Gardens on the first Sunday.

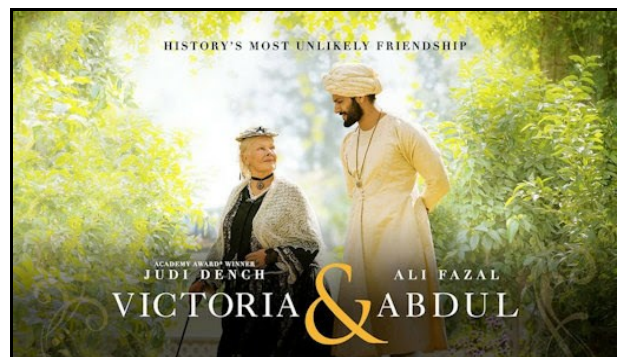


August 26.

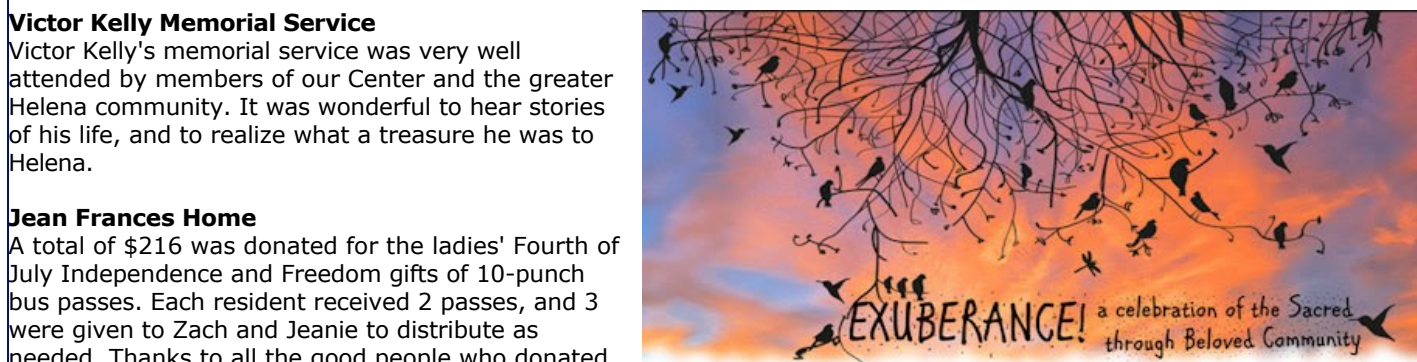
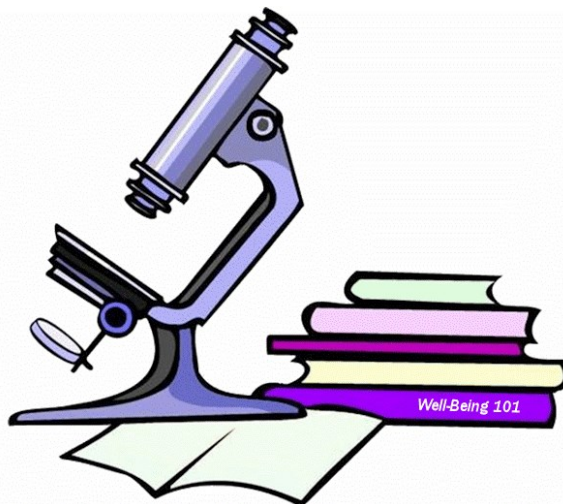
