This month's title, "When the Land Belonged to God," is borrowed from one of Montana's favorite artists, Charlie Russell. Painted in 1914, the original work is hung at our own Historical Society Museum. The painting is a nostalgic look backward at the artist's youth spent as a cowhand at the fringes of the Westward Expansion of the United States.

As we enter the Medicine through the Native American perspective, we understand that the Medicine Wheel is one of the first cosmological descriptions of the Universe. It is also a primary healing technology.

Everything is contained within the Medicine Wheel: galaxies, microbes, governments, nations, races, and religions; everything is included, and everything is equal. The Medicine Wheel represents the entire Intelligent and Co-creative Universe.

As a healing technology, one can use it for guidance, for release, for inspiration; it is impossible to describe all of the medicines. When one stands within the balance of the Four Directions, feet on mother earth, hands raised to grandfather sky, asking for direction, or the healing of a relationship, the Universe always responds. Indigenous cultures have always known this, and metaphysics echoes this fundamental truth.

Everything belongs to God, because Source includes all of Its creation. Nothing, no one, and no sentient life is forgotten or abandoned. Science of Mind teaches that there is only One Life, the Life of God, which includes all of life, and is your very life right now.

that comes towards me.

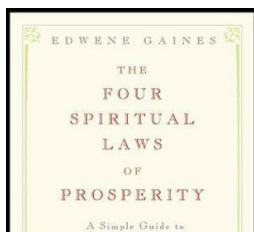

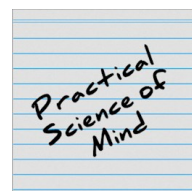
October 28: *Giveaway*
