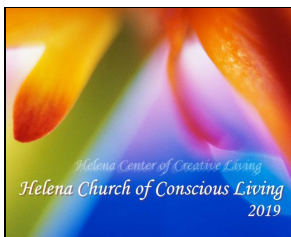

Dec. 2: Celebrating the Divine Light of Hanukkah
