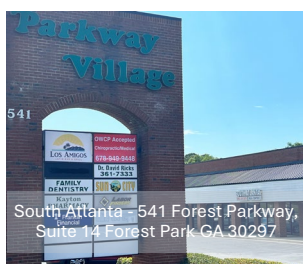
2. Oral Tablets:

Nadidum D8	2.0 mg	Supports cell metabolism

Alpha-lipoic acid D6	2.0 mg	Antioxidant, supports nerve repair
Cartilago suis D6	2.0 mg	Cartilage regeneration
Embryo suis D6	2.0 mg	Regenerative support
Funiculus umbilicalis suis D6	2.0 mg	Connective tissue repair
Placenta suis D6	2.0 mg	Tissue healing, anti-inflammatory

Excipients:

- Sodium chloride
- Water for injection

Note: D-potencies refer to decimal homeopathic dilutions (1:10 dilution steps).

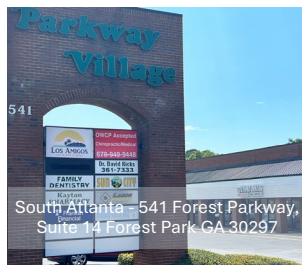
Contraindications:

- **Known hypersensitivity** to any component of the formula, particularly **Arnica montana** or **Rhus toxicodendron**
- Use caution in **pregnant or breastfeeding women**—consult a healthcare provider
- Not recommended in patients with **autoimmune diseases** without supervision

Precautions and Warnings:

- Should be administered under **clinical supervision** when used by injection
