### ORDINANCE NO. 2019-

KADE HOLLIDAY

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE CITY OF BAY, ARKANSAS, AS A C THE FIRST CLASS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas adopted Act 269 of 1971 providing that cities of the second class, having a population of 1,500 or more could become cities of the first class; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bay, Arkansas, according to the regular Federal Census taken in 2010, has a population of more than 1,500 persons,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY, ARKANSAS;

That from and after the passage of this Ordinance, the City of Bay, Section 1. Arkansas shall be a first class city, as provided by the laws of the State of Arkansas, and shall have all of the rights, powers, privileges and duties provided for cities of the first class under the laws of the State of Arkansas.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby Section 2. repealed. Adopted this It of February, 2019.
