This Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between **Jeffrey L. Walls**, hereinafter referred to as the "Officiant," and _____ hereinafter referred to as the "Couple," on _____, 20____.

Services:

The Officiant agrees to provide wedding officiation services for the Couple's wedding ceremony on _____, 20____. This includes crafting a personalized ceremony script, up to 4 consultations to discuss ceremony details, rehearsal coordination (if applicable), and incorporating cultural elements, rituals, and personalized vows.

Consultations:

The Couple will receive up to 4 consultations with the Officiant to discuss ceremony details, preferences, and any special requests. Consultations may take place in person or virtually, ensuring effective communication and collaboration.

Rehearsal (if applicable):

If a rehearsal is requested, the Officiant will attend and coordinate the wedding rehearsal to ensure a seamless ceremony. Rehearsal details will be discussed and agreed upon during consultations.

Fees:

The Couple agrees to pay the Officiant the total fee of \$_____ for the services outlined in this Agreement. A non-refundable deposit of **\$50.00** is due upon signing this Agreement, with the remaining balance due no later than 7 days prior to the wedding.

Cancellation Policy:

In the event of cancellation, the Couple agrees to notify the Officiant as soon as possible. The non-refundable deposit will not be returned. If cancellation occurs within 7 days of the wedding date, the Couple is responsible for the full payment.

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**Travel (if applicable):**

If the wedding location is beyond **50 Miles**, additional travel expenses of \$2.00 per mile will be charged. Example: 80 Miles - 50 miles = 30 miles x \$2.00 = \$60 Additional Charge.

Agreement Changes:

Any changes or modifications to this Agreement must be made in writing and agreed upon by both parties.

Governing Law:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Franklin County Pennsylvania
