

Position Title: Kids Ministry Volunteer

Key Responsibilities:

 - Engage children with age-appropriate Bible stories, activities, crafts, and games.
2. **Build Relationships:**
 - Establish positive, supportive relationships with children, parents, and fellow volunteers.
 - Be approachable and available to listen, encourage, and mentor children as needed.
3. **Support Event Planning and Execution:**
 - Assist in planning and organizing children's ministry events, such as holiday parties, and outreach activities.
 - Help set up and clean up before and after events.
4. **Maintain a Safe Environment:**
 - Ensure that all children are supervised at all times and that safety guidelines are followed.
 - Report any concerns or incidents to the Kids Ministry Coordinator immediately.
5. **Participate in Training and Meetings:**
 - Attend regular training sessions, meetings, and planning sessions to stay informed and engaged with the ministry's goals and activities.
 - Participate in background checks and child protection training as required.

6. Encourage and Support Spiritual Growth:

- Model Christian behavior and demonstrate a personal commitment to Jesus Christ.
 - Encourage children to participate in prayer, worship, and Bible study.
