*Kids Club:*

- I wish I could take you with me every Saturday on my routine. I am amazed how my kids and their mothers receive me each week with such joy!
- I also find myself with a wonderful problem; my Kids Club keeps growing and growing. I now have 80 kids enrolled!
- Currently my lessons have been geared towards the Lord's death and resurrection as we approached Easter.
  - o Mexico teaches of Christ's suffering and how they need to equally punish themselves for their sins. It is a sad week, watching them beat themselves, and even going as far as crucifying themselves to seek God's forgiveness. My goal is to help them understand what He did for them, but also understand it is a gift that cannot be bought or one they must suffer for, to accept.
- The end of April (*the 29<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup>*) and May 2<sup>nd</sup>, is the next big Kids Club events I am preparing for. Our annual Carnival. I have rented space to host it at, and I am preparing the games we will play. This is a great event that I enjoy so much, and it also allows me to utilize the teens from church as volunteers!

*Vacation Bible School:*

- I am working through a huge challenge this year for my Vacation Bible School schedule. This year, the kids are not out of school for their Summer until July 25<sup>th</sup>. (*I typically start hosting VBS much earlier*)
- We have put our problem-solving skills to the challenge and so far, we are hosting 2 separate Vacation Bible Schools during a 3-week break that all schools will be taking for our City Fair in April.
- This will be the incredibly jam-packed schedule:
  - o April 19<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> (Wednesday – Friday) Vacation Bible School
  - o April 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> (Tuesday – Friday) Vacation Bible School
  - o April 29<sup>th</sup> (Saturday) We will host the 1<sup>st</sup> Carnival for my Kids Club members.

- April 30<sup>th</sup> (Sunday) We will host the 2<sup>nd</sup> Carnival at the church where VBS will be held on April 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> (*We are encouraging the parents to attend this event as it will be on a scheduled church day!*)
- May 2<sup>nd</sup> (Tuesday) We will host a 3<sup>rd</sup> Carnival in the city of Cumbres, where a Children's Feeding Center is located.

### *Counseling & Training:*

- I continue to have the opportunity to work in the Drug Rehabilitation Center weekly. My prayer is the time spent there will help them leave behind their addictions.
- I have been dealing with a new challenge since our world went through the pandemic. These last 3+ years have affected everyone differently, but they have really had a dark impact on young teens. I currently meet with teens, ages 12-14 weekly. This has really stretched me in my counseling abilities and is definitely outside my comfort zone! It is so hard to see them fearful and disconnected from their parents.

- The teens God has entrusted to me in counseling.
- Those addicted to drugs to find a release.
- The darkness that surrounds Aguascalientes through frequent suicides.
