This year was unique in that I had a week-long celebration with a party every day! This was a first for me, but I must admit, I LOVED every minute of it! ### What's New in Aguascalientes?

#### Kids' Carnival

Do you really have a Kids Ministry if you don't host a carnival for them to launch into Summer?! LOL On April 30<sup>th</sup>, we did just that! A national here, named Gris, hosts her own Kids Club, but we decided to join forces! Between our two clubs, we had 100 kids present, 30 volunteers, (*many of which were teens from my church*) and 12 mothers. We had different stations setup with games for the kids to rotate through and they had a BLAST! The icing on top, one of the moms accepted the Lord as her Savior!

#### Kids Club

This year, I have extended the weeks I host Kids Club due to so many events going on. I typically close out the Club year earlier, but this year it ended up being June 25<sup>th</sup>. With the local school year being much different than the public schools in the states, their last day of school will be July 15<sup>th</sup>. This can be challenging trying to schedule VBS in-between such a short summer break.

#### Vacation Bible School

This year's theme for VBS will be "Detective Academy Secret Agents" I have never used this theme before, so I have a LOT of props and supplies to make! I currently have 5 scheduled Vacation Bible Schools with approximately 100 kids each. That is roughly 500+ crafts to have ready. One challenge in Mexico, is the access to the materials needed. Most of the time, I must get creative and put some elbow grease into the preparation. The schedule of VBS this year will look something like this:

- Day one, we will be talking about each child's uniqueness, using their fingerprint.
- Day two, we will talk about the bomb of sin, and how it affected all of us, using a safe explosive to teach this lesson.
- Day three, we will talk about how God solved the problem of sin in our lives.
