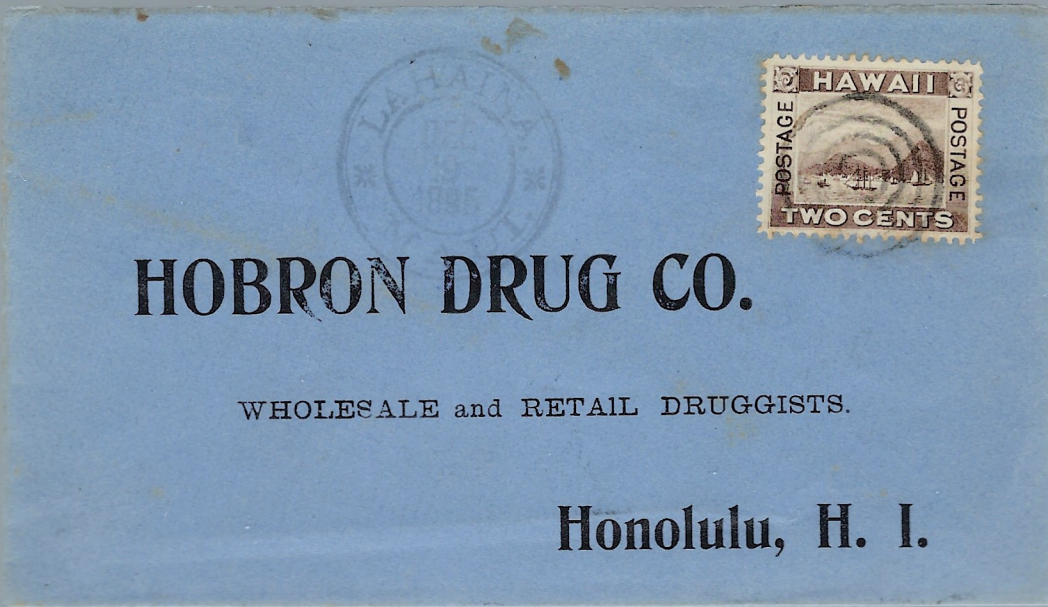

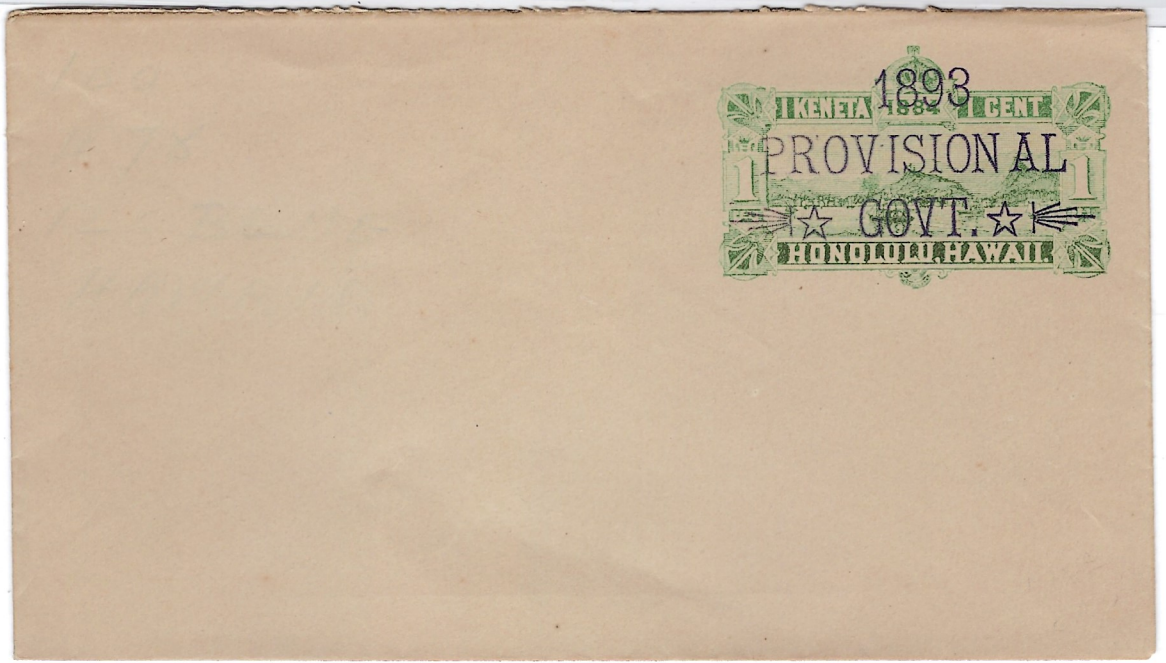
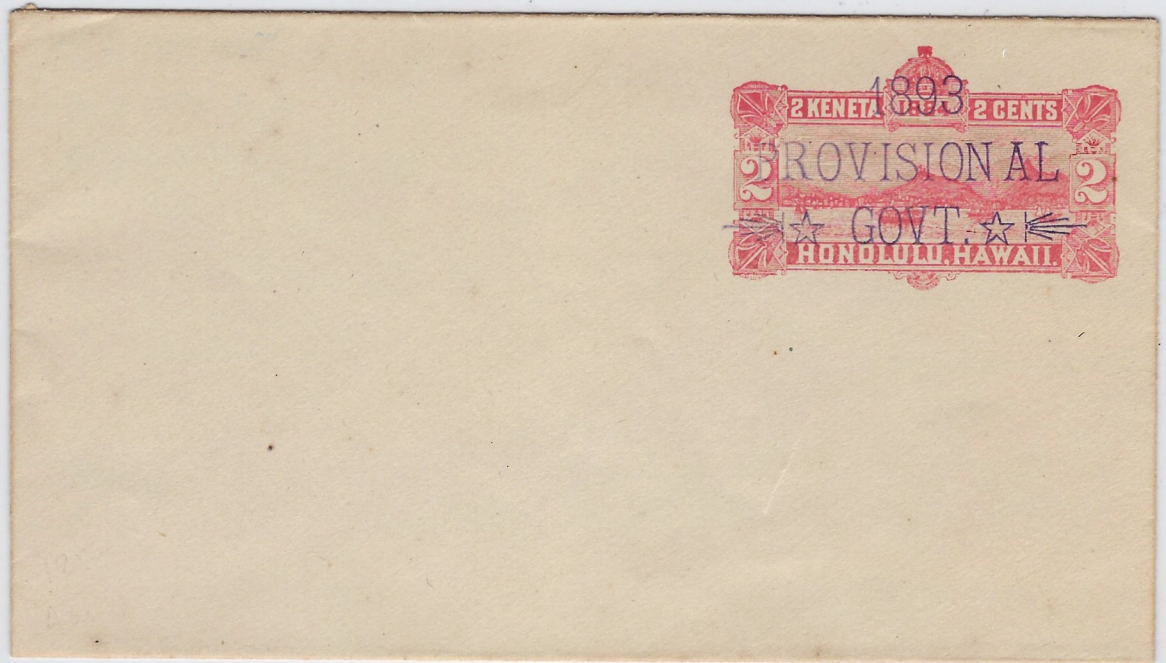

1893 PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OVERPRINTS PRODUCED IN FOUR OVERPRINTINGS BY THE GAZETTE COMPANY

Featured on the following page is a cover that was sent with fourteen 10¢ black Provisional Government overprint stamps. It was mailed registered, first to Australia before reaching its destination in Liverpool, England.

With a \$1.40 total in postage, this letter could mail a letter up to 26 ounces. As it is not likely that this letter actually carried that much mail, it was probably a philatelic cover.

The letter is marked with a Honolulu datestamp, a Hawaii registered "R" handstamp, a New York registration tag, and a Liverpool Registered handstamp.
