



# Club Charter



## The club will:

Ensure that all coaches and regular volunteers undertake an Enhanced DBS check every 3 years

Ensure all coaches undertake annual CPD in coaching techniques, safeguarding and concussion protocols

Provide access to a named Child Welfare Officer at all times

Provide qualified first aiders at all sessions

Provide regular opportunities for members to train and play games between February and October

Communicate fixtures and training sessions with as much notice as possible

Ensure that training equipment is kept in serviceable use and is safe to use

Ensure that volunteers place the enjoyment and safety of members as their prime motivation for helping out.



## Players will:

Ensure they uphold the good name of the club at all times both on and off the field

Listen to and respect coaches at all times

Act safely in training and games, ensuring that their actions allow themselves and others to always have fun

Arrive prepared and on time to training sessions and games

Never argue with match officials, or engage in arguments with officials from other teams

Recognise that they are a member of a team and are no more important than any other team member

Thank coaches and other volunteers for their time and effort at the end of sessions

Assist in clearing away equipment at the end of sessions



## Parents will:

Ensure they uphold the good name of the club, showing respect always

Respond to match and training invitations in a timely manner

Place the emphasis of their child's participation on having fun and getting better at rugby league, rather than defining success solely on the final score

Ensure their children arrive prepared and on time to training sessions and games

Never argue with match officials, or engage in arguments with officials/visitors from other teams

Never make public comparisons between their own children and the performance of other players or volunteers

Thank coaches and other volunteers for their time and effort at the end of sessions

Ensure any concerns are discussed with the Child Welfare Officer confidentially
