Player registration and membership fees

Registrations for the new season will be open shortly. Those players who have previously registered on the RFL platform should have a simple re-registration process to follow. We will send the relevant link as soon as it becomes available.

You may be aware that this year, the RFL have introduced a player membership fee for the first time, in a scheme named Our League Active. Like many other sports, the charge is being made by the RFL to participants in order to help fund the administration and development of the community game. The scheme not only covers player insurance, it also provides a host of other new benefits for all registered players.

In Nottinghamshire, the fee has been set at £12 for U11s and £15 for all other age groups. The club have elected to collect this fee on your behalf, when you pay your subs, rather than you having to make a separate payment to the RFL on registration.

We realise that this means a more expensive membership fee for the club and have decided to offset this by adding value to what you receive as part of our own club fees:

- * Longer playing season
- * Monthly top trainer prizes
- * Free tickets for all players and parents at the October 2022 awards

Therefore, the membership fees for the year (incorporating your membership of the Our League Active platform) will be as follows:

1st child - £95 2nd and subsequent children - £75

Payment in instalments is available by arrangement.

BREAKING NEWS: Training for the 2022 season is to begin on Saturday 26th February 2022.

We look forward to our first training session of the season as part of our pre-season preparations. Sessions will focus on core skill development, strength and conditioning and a range of exciting skills-based games.

Sessions will run for all age groups, each Saturday in March, by which time we hope to be ready for our first fixtures.

Wednesday evening sessions will recommence on 30th March, once the clocks have changed.
