### IS IT A VALIANT?? OR A DUSTER???

This is a 1970 Plymouth Duster 340 built by Mr. Curtis Dorman of Melbourne, Florida. It is pretty much back to original build. A 833 4 speed, 3.91 rear gear. Engine build is by Randy at Brevard Cylinder Heads, 40 over Keith Black pistons, Comp Cam, Clay Smith lifters and push rods. Cylinder heads were done by Space Coast Speed Shop and Crank by Jon Brunson, Crankmaster, Palm Bay. It's a F4 light lime green with black bucket seat interior. The 1970 was actually a one year Valiant Duster. In '71 they removed the Valiant badging. They made a whole bunch of Dusters between 1970 and around about 1976 with many engine and transmission combinations and several special models too. They are fun cars to drive and I really enjoy mine. My first Duster I purchased was in 1972 when I was a junior in high school; a 1970 340 Duster with Torqflight automatic. It was a F8 green with green bench seat interior. Started drag racing it in 1974 with a few modifications: 12.83, best 1/4 mile time. That was a long time ago, LOL!!


