SHARON'S PEANUT BUTTER SQUARES

For those who may not have attended the July club meeting, Sharon provided us with some delicious sweets. The following is the recipe.

Peanut Butter mixture

2 C. graham cracker crumbs1 lb. powder sugar2 sticks Parkay margarine1 C. Peanut Butter (smooth)1 tsp. vanilla

Mix all together & press mixture into a 9 X 12 pan.

Topping

Melt 12 oz. Semi Sweet Chocolate Chips & ¾ stick of margarine together and put on top of peanut butter mixture. Spread & refrigerate 10 minutes. Then take back out of the frig & cut before it becomes firm. (If you wait to cut the squares, the top comes away from the bottom.) So always cut before it gets firm and then put back in the frig until ready to serve.
