1966 Dodge Coronet fourdoor Sedan Mecum

It's been reported that 10,904 426 Hemi-powered street Mopars left Dodge and Plymouth assembly plants between1966—71. The engine was available in a litany of models and body styles over the years, including fan favorites like the Plymouth 'Cuda and Dodge Charger. Tied for the rarest are the 1970 Dodge Coronet R/T convertible and the 1966 Dodge Coronet four-door sedan. Only two of each were built and all four cars survive today.


