Note also above, moving boxes in the main garage.

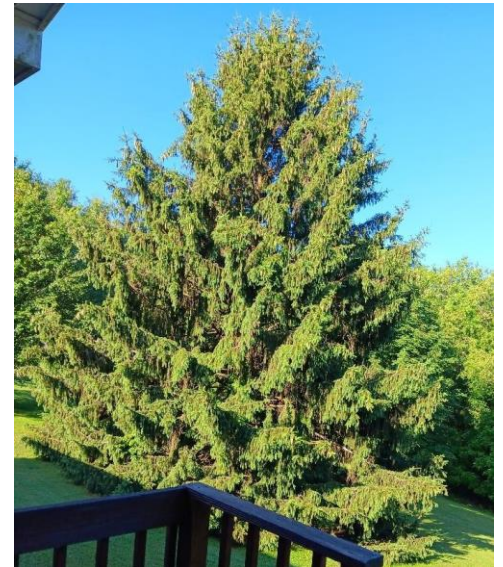


Moving furniture into the Living room

Visiting Mobsters in North Carolina

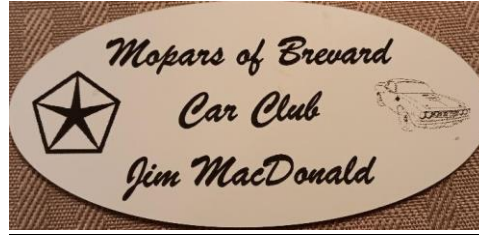


