





Jim Morrison, the Doors band front/man began life as a child in Florida on the Indian River. His modest home is at 2100 Vernon Place, Melbourne. His childhood home is on a side street in Melbourne, where most people may simply drive by and not realize the significance of the place.

An iconic performer, uunfortunately Morrison died -- or disappeared -- in Paris in 1971, at the age of 27. During the preceding four years, the Doors had risen from the bars of Los Angeles to become, by some accounts, the American Beatles. They were the first American hard-rock group to record five consecutive gold albums.


