Dare To Be Different: Super Freak Superbird Pickup. Submitted by Penny Anderson

Preserving Mopar A100 Pickup History

This 1966 Dodge A100 pickup with a Superbird wing was a local Indiana hot-rodding icon before being mothballed. Now it's uncovered after nearly half a century.

Fortunately, the history of this 1966 A100 pickup is well-documented, and its storyline provides remarkable insight into the lifecycle of classic trucks and how precious few of them have transformed from utilitarian workhorses early in life into show-stopping centerpieces—and, in this case, all the fun steps in between. According to Cory, it was originally minted in light blue with a 273ci LA-series small-block. (Dodge was the only truck manufacturer that ever built an FC pickup with a V-8.) The first owner of this 1966 A100 pickup was Chrysler itself, and it was initially used as a yard truck for about 10 years at Dodge's Warren, Michigan, truck plant where it was built.

The <u>Dodge A100 pickup truck</u> was built from 1964 to 1970 and shared its 90-inch wheelbase with the Dodge A100 van. It was virtually guaranteed to go down in hot-rodding history as utterly forgettable until a racer named Bill "Maverick" Golden immortalized the Dodge A100 pickup as the <u>Little Red Wagon</u>, first in NHRA Factory Experimental, then as a wheel-standing exhibition match racer. As a result, you couldn't be a kid in the 1960s and 1970s without being familiar with the A100's freakish proportions and outrageous stance!


